1. Reduce your risk for infection.

Wear a mask, practice social distancing and wash hands frequently.

2. Get vaccinated + boosted.

COVID-19 vaccines help keep you from getting very sick from COVID-19. Receive the full dose including booster to maximize your immunity.

3. Get tested.

If you are feeling sick or believe you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID, get tested and isolate until receiving a negative test.

4. If you are sick, talk to a doctor.

Enroll in Medicaid, CHIP or an Affordable Care plan so you can visit a doctor and take care of your and your family's health!

How to Use this At-Home COVID-19 Rapid Test Kit

Additional instructions in box.

1. You swab your nose using the swab in the package.
2. Put the swab in the small test tube provided and wait 5 minutes.
3. Add 3 drops from test tube onto test strip. Wait 15 minutes.
4. Compare your test strip to pictures in the instructions to see if the test is positive or negative for COVID-19.

What do my results mean?

Positive Result



A **POSITIVE** result must show **BOTH** a C line and a T line

Negative Result



A **NEGATIVE** result will show **ONLY** a C line

If POSITIVE

- Your results show the virus is present in your body.
- Stay home or isolate for 5 days and wear a mask if others could have contact with you.
- Tell a doctor and stay in contact with them. If your illness becomes severe, seek medical attention.
- Tell your close contacts that they may have been exposed to COVID-19.

If NEGATIVE

- Your results show the virus is not present.
- Your test may not turn positive yet if you have been infected in the past 1-3 days.
- **If you have COVID-19 symptoms, isolate & talk to a doctor no matter what your test result.**



For extra peace of mind:

For example if visiting your 95 year old grandmother, you could test yourself 3 days before the visit, strictly limit contact with other people, and then test again on the day of the visit.
